

## **Report on Visit of Mark Taylor in Salzgitter / Braunschweig**

Starting on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup>, ending on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2012

The team of Braunschweig chapter provided 4 major meetings:

- Saturday, 9 to 11 am, chapter meeting with breakfast in a Braunschweig hotel
- Saturday night, prayer meeting in a Salzgitter church
- Sunday morning, Sunday service in a Salzgitter church
- Monday, 7 to 11 pm, chapter meeting with Mark Taylor

The chapter meeting on Saturday was lead by the Holy Spirit. Mark gave his testimony and afterwards he and the FGBMFI men prayed for salvation, for healing the sick, healing of soul issues. Many miracles happened. Prophetic words were given. Some thirty visitors attended, most of them church visitors.

Saturday night the church in Salzgitter which most of the chapter members belong to had a prayer meeting. This night they opened their meeting for the topic "Transforming Communities, Cities and Nations". FGBMFI was welcomed. Mark shared about his experience and what it is about to work together. He explained the established fact that it may become very difficult when churches want to lead transformation movements. But instead many of these movements are lead by business men or business organisation. The business men are capable to not only organise but also to take the lead because between many pastors and churches at one city there are competition and even jealousy. Mark also told about the importance of prayer and of the importance to personally reach out. The night ended with a prayer community. Some 20 visitors attended, 3 pastors among them.

Sunday morning Mark was invited to preach in the same church. He emphasised the importance of personal responsibility for the city and of commitment to the aim of transformation. Then he also touched that the Braunschweig chapter has a vision to reach ten cities in the region around the cities of Braunschweig and Salzgitter. The pastor of that church agreed.

Sunday afternoon a small group of chapter members visited the highest hill near the city of Salzgitter. Mark prayed for the whole region and bound the evil spirits.

Monday evening we had a meeting in the house where Mark and Monika and I slept. The whole chapter team attended. It turned out that they are very committed to transformation. They developed the aim of reaching their region and to help establish new chapters in 10 cities around them. Finally they decided to start the transformation process now; and to steadily pray for their region which shall be touched by transformation. Mark was invited to come again and follow up.

Personal impression: Germany needs transformation. Mark Taylor is welcome to fulfil his mission in the Braunschweig-Salgitter region together with the chapter team. Once this will be a success it can be multiplied to other regions in Germany. Mark himself is a humble servant of God full with the Holy Spirit. He is trustworthy.
